Waterview Landing Homeowners Association Semi-Annual Homeowners Association Meeting December 11, 2024 at 7pm Pine Rock Firehouse

Meeting opened at 7:06 PM

Attending:

Board: Doug Dempsey (DD) #9, Faylynn Haight (FH) #27, George Berntsen (GB) #28

Homeowners: Mayra Rosario #3, Elaine Rifkin #19, Michael Passaro #21, Johanna Passaro #21, Bob Gesullo #23, Joe Nechasek #25, Rod Tomey #26, Jon Haight #27, Nancy Berntsen #28.

DD opened the meeting by thanking Bob Gesullo for his serving on the Board for the past twenty years.

BUDGET (FH)

- Reviewed the 2024 actual and 2025 proposed HOA budget.
- FH pointed out that the monthly common charge would increase from \$230 to \$250 beginning in January.
- Joe N. questioned the basis for the monthly common charge increase.

 DD explained there were three reasons: (1) The new tree reserve item so trimming can occur in 3 years without a special charge. (2) The 2025 budget also increases the general reserve from \$5000 to \$7500. (3) Landscaping contract increased.
- Discussed coring and seeding one-time charge. It was asked how often this would be done. Mike P. explained it wouldn't be needed for several years. He said to expect significant lawn improvement in Spring.
- Johanna P asked, "how long is the landscape contract?" FH answered 3 years. 2 years remaining.
- Elaine R. asked where the snow removal cost in the budget. FH said it is in the Landscaping budget item. No 2025 increase in the snow removal portion.
- Some discussion about landscaping being sloppy in the fall but overall favorable.
 Rod T. said Smitty has been the best landscaper in 18 years. General agreement.
- Bob G. asked followed up on tree trimming reserved. Where will the money go? FH said the funds would be kept in the Association's money market account. Nancy B asked what the interest rate is. Faylynn said she negotiated 3% rate.
- Joe N. made a motion to approve the budget. Elaine R. seconded the motion. Approved unanimously.

OTHER DISCUSSION ITEMS

- FH announced that the Board of Directors insurance carrier will no longer provide our policy. A new insurance provider was secured
- DD described an incident that a tree in our Common area fell on a Quail Circle neighbor's fence. The HOA had to pay to fell the tree and repair the fence. DD asked homeowners to notice and report dead trees. Bob G. said a similar incident happened in the past. George B. suggested having an arborist evaluate HOA common property trees that could have property damage potential.

ACTION ITEM: DD will send out a notice to homeowners to pay notice to dead trees and report to the board.

• Johanna P. said there is a dead tree on the Stowe Drive side of the walking path stone wall. It was discussed that the Stowe Drive owner would have to be informed.

ACTION ITEM: Johanna P. to show DD the dead tree in question.

Nancy B. suggested adding more noticeable numbers to houses. General
discussion about the difficulty of reading the house numbers for delivery and
emergency services. Doug D. agreed that a standardized placard should be
mounted on all houses be a common contractor.

ACTION ITEM: Board to take up a task to add a more noticeable, standardized number placard to all homes.

- Rod T. brought up a problem with the keyed P.O. Box. He spoke with the USPS carrier, and she said they will fix it.
- Johanna P. asked about board members. DD explained that Bob G. resigned and the Board appointed George B. to fill the open position until the next board elections.
- Rod T. brought up Craftsman list. Suggested we update it with homeowner(s) who have used a particular contractor.

ACTION ITEM: Board to send out a request to owners for contractor recommendations. Susan Vallillo to update the list she maintains.

Johanna asked if the board would approve money for Christmas wreath on WL sign.
 Doug D. said \$50 would be ok.
